- The Promoter is Victoria Racing Club Limited (ACN 119 214 078) of 448 Epsom Road, Flemington VIC 3031 ("Promoter").

Employees, directors and other representatives of the Promoter and organisations involved in sponsoring or conducting this Promotion (and any individuals so involved) are ineligible, as are members of their immediate families and households.

- 6. Incomplete, inaccurate, illegible, or photocopied entries will be deemed invalid. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for lost, late or misdirected entries.
