Raffle Name

Promoter

Raffle Period

Entry Restrictions

Entry is open to residents aged 18 years in Victoria

Raffle Entry Procedure

To enter, entrants must purchase a paper ticket during the Raffle Period. Purchase either a single ticket for the Raffle (**Single Raffle Ticket**) valued at \$10.00 each including providing all details requested.

Maximum Number of Raffle Tickets

Maximum Number of Entries

There is no limit to the number of entries per entrant, subject to Raffle Ticket availability.

Entrant Conditions

Directors, management, employees and contractors of the Promoter and those of any agencies, retailers and suppliers associated with this Raffle and the immediate family members of these people are ineligible to enter. "Immediate family member" means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether by natural or by adoption), grand child or step-grandchild, parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
